While **Jay Bender**, president of **Falcon Plastics**, **Inc.**, in Brookings, S.D., has eaten a few Big Macs, he won't be suing McDonald's for weight gain. But frivolous lawsuits are proliferating. The U.S. legal system costs \$246 billion a year, twice as much as any other country. So Bender has joined with the NAM and the American Justice Partnership to restore sanity through legal and judicial reform. "We should spend our resources not on liability insurance, but on education and investments in our future," he says. We think it's an open-and-shut case.
