# ALLENSWORTH REDEDICATION

## COMMEMORATING THE FIRST SELF-GOVERNED BLACK TOWNSHIP IN CALIFORNIA.

Travel through a powerful moment in history with Amtrak San Joaquins! Start from Southern California, the Bay Area, or the Central Valley—right to the doorstep of this historic landmark and festival.

Over a century ago, Colonel Allen Allensworth and four other settlers established a town founded, financed and governed by African Americans—a place where hard work, dedication, and faith would allow them and their children the opportunity to control their own discrimination-free destiny.

In 1974, California State Parks purchased land within the historical townsite of Allensworth, and it became Colonel Allensworth State Historic Park. Today a collection of lovingly restored and reconstructed early 20th-century buildings—including the Colonel's house, historic schoolhouse, church, and library—once again dots this flat farm country, giving new life to the dreams of these visionary pioneers.
